EVALUATE YOUR SAFETY RECORD WITH THE NATIONAL AGC SAFETY AWARDS (NASA)

It only takes 5 minutes to complete; Deadline February 4

The National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program offers AGC members an opportunity to evaluate their safety record. It only takes a few minutes to submit with your completed OSHA 300A log. Completed participant forms are due to AGC of Ohio by February 4. [View the instructions and access the participant form.](#)

All participating contractors receive a confidential printout to compare their company's safety statistics with similar size and type AGC contractor members both locally and nationally. (Individual company names and information are kept confidential.) Additionally, this information can be used to assist in determining if additional accident prevention and loss-control measures are necessary.

Companies that have participated for three consecutive years and have a 2014 incident rate 25 percent below their division average will receive a Certificate of Commendation for Safety Excellence. The certificates will be presented during the AGC of Ohio Safety Luncheon in the spring.

DON'T FORGET TO POST YOUR OSHA 300 LOGS!

Employers who are required to keep Form 300, the Injury and Illness log, must post Form 300A, the Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses, in a workplace every year from February 1 to April 30. Current and former employees, or their representatives, have the right to access injury and illness records. Employers must give the requester a copy of the relevant record(s) by the end of the next business day. [Learn more.](#)
