2019-2020 Scholarship Application

DESCRIPTION

One scholarship for \$1,000 will be awarded annually to a Ruhlin employee or relative (spouse, dependents or grandchildren) to be applied to an undergraduate course of study. The award will be disbursed in May 2019. All applicants will be notified as to whether or not they receive a scholarship.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following requirements to qualify for this scholarship:

- An undergraduate student.
- The undergraduate must be in at least the second year of a 4-year or 5-year degree program or in the first year of a 2-year degree program at a college or university at the time of application. (Preferably a construction-related career track, but not required.)
- Minimum overall grade point average of 2.5 (out of 4.0), or equivalent.
- A U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Currently employed by The Ruhlin Co. or a relative of a Ruhlin salary or hourly employee. If the applicant is a relative of an hourly employee or an hourly employee, the employee must have worked 1,000 hours in the previous calendar year.
